WHAT IS IT?

Love Bites is a Respectful Relationships Education Program for 15 – 17 year olds.

It consists of two interactive workshops: one on Relationship Violence and one on Sex and Relationships followed by creative workshops and community campaigns.

Love Bites is a flexible model with options to use a full day or multi session delivery approach. The program emphasises the importance of a whole of school commitment to respectful relationship education.



WHO CAN RUN LOVE BITES?

The program is suitable for any professional who works with young people and is comfortable working in the areas of Relationship Violence and Sex and Relationships.



TRAINING IN THE PROGRAM INCLUDES:

- 2 days training that covers best practice models, theoretical backgrounds, gender, facilitator skills, practical experiences with the activities and planning around actual delivery in your local context. Also included in the training is the Love Bites Junior Program which is RESPECTFUL RELATIONSHIP lesson plans for young people in Years 7–9
- USB with all materials to run the programs.
